## 5. BUSINESS:

A. Resolution 20-17 Stubler. Discussion. Approve/Reject. Motion by Lehman to approve resolution 20-17 directing the Mayor & Clerk to execute the warranty deed for the sale of a Stubler lot to Alfred Flaschberger. Supported by Kuechle. Motion carried unanimously.

- B. Resolution 20-18 Stubler. Discussion. Approve/Reject. Motion by Markas to approve resolution 20-18 authorizing the Stubler lot sale to Alfred Flaschberger. Supported by Kuechle Motion carried unanimously.
- C. Sign Purchase. Discussion. Approve/Reject. Motion by Lehman to purchase 5 under surveillance signs at \$19.80, 10 no parking at \$35.05, 3 no dumping at \$19.75, and 10 no motorized vehicles at \$17.75. Supported by Milich. Motion carried unanimously.
- D. Buhl School. Discussion. Approve/Reject. The Council discussed options for the school relating to a potential sale, demolition, and winterizing options. No action taken.
- E. Covid-19 Update-Informational. Discussion. Approve/Reject. Clerk Pervenanze stated that the City still plans to hold spring cleanup. Dates will be set after the stay at home order lifts. The beach & campground will remain closed until the Governor allows these activities to resume. St. Louis County still plans to have their board meeting in Buhl on May 26<sup>th</sup>. Details regarding the meeting & public participation have not been released. AEOA has extended crisis funds for utility payments for residents who may need assistance.

## Council Reports/Other Business:

- Councilor Lehman stated that the Fire Department would like to move Engine 2 up the bus garage. RAMS has been meeting via Zoom.
- Councilor Markas mentioned a few issues in the Whiteside Industrial Park
  that BEDA will address. Motorized vehicles are not allowed within City
  parks, The City will be cracking down on violators soon. Councilor Markas
  also addressed the increased use of the recycling areas and would like to
  explore options for more capacity.
- Mayor Klarich stated that the City will be staring blight enforcement soon. A newsletter will be going out with the relevant information.
