! SPRING BLIGHT SWEEPS • BEGIN WEEK OF MAY 4th, 2026

Blight ordinances are enforced year-round – please take action now!

The Chisholm Police Department will begin city-wide blight sweeps starting the week of May 4th, 2026. These efforts are part of our commitment to keeping Buhl safe, clean, and welcoming for city residents and visitors alike.

COMMON VIOLATIONS TO CORRECT NOW:



Public Nuisance

Misdemeanor punishable by up to \$1000 in fines and/or 90 days in jail. (Chapter 10)



Grass, Weeds & Shrubs

Maintain vegetation/grass below 10 inches and off sidewalks (Chapter 92)



Litter and Refuse on Private Property

In all areas, all waste material, debris, refuse, or garbage shall be kept in an enclosed building, or properly contained in a closed container designed for such purpose. **Including Dog Feces** (Chapters 92.15, 92.16, 92.18)



Litter on Streets, Gutters, and Sidewalks

No person may deposit litter or refuse on City Streets, curbs, gutters, sidewalks (Chapter 92, Section 92.18).



Junk or Unlicensed Vehicles/ Household Appliances: It is unlawful to park or store unlicensed, unregistered, or inoperable vehicles, household furnishings or appliances on public or private property. (Chapter 92, Section 92.18 Ordinance 18-2)



Nuisance Parking No more than 4 vehicles per dwelling unit on residential property. (Chapter 92, Section 92.18 Ordinance 18-3)

We understand that the current economic climate has made it difficult for some to manage property upkeep. Officers will continue to lead with understanding and provide reasonable time frames for compliance. However, if violations are not addressed within the allotted time, citations may be issued in accordance with city ordinances.
